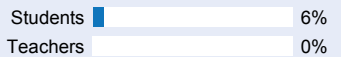

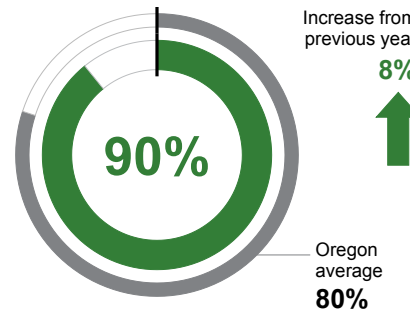

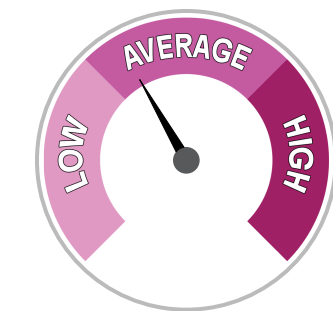

INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

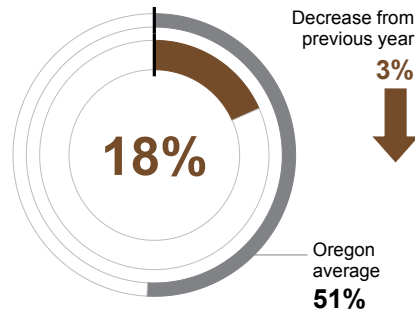
Year-to-year progress in English language arts and mathematics.

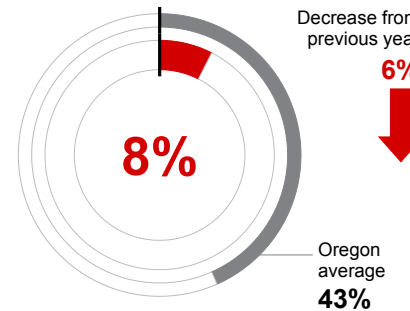
ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



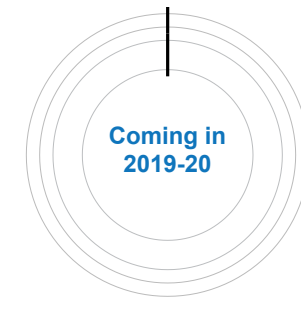
MATHEMATICS

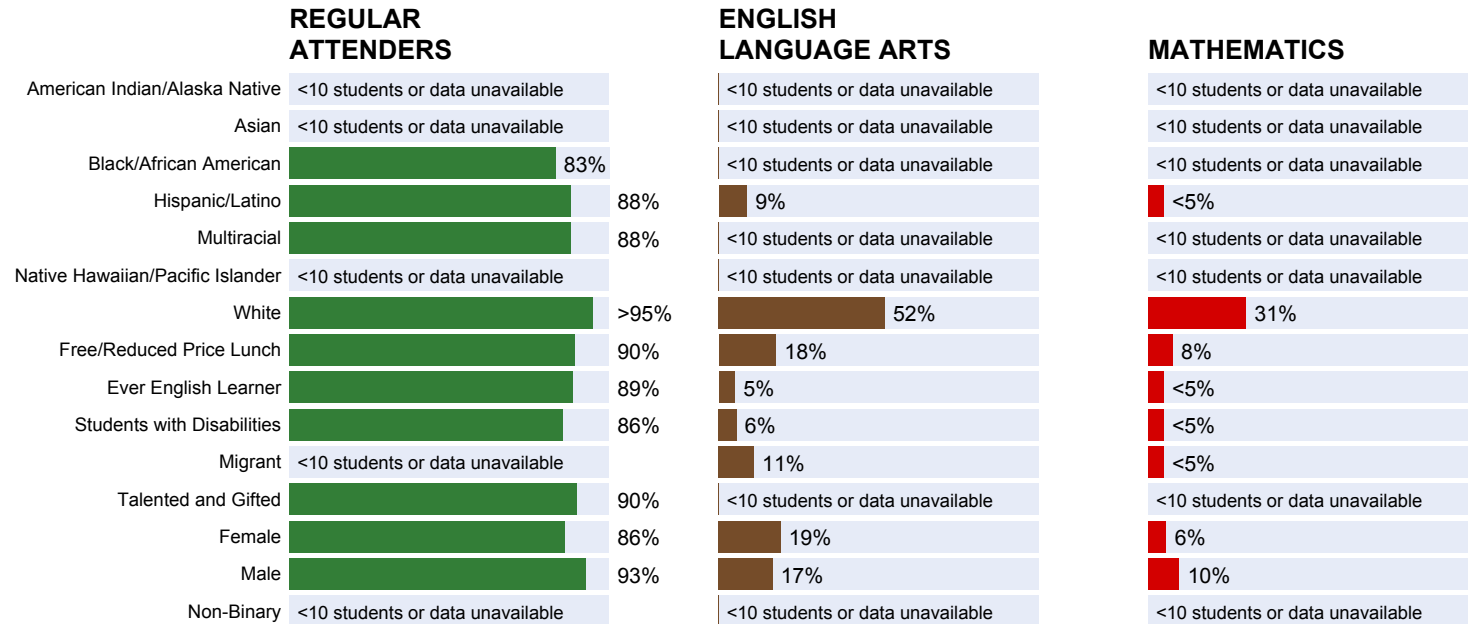

About Our School

BULLYING, HARASSMENT, AND SAFETY POLICIES

Portland Public Schools has created policies to help our schools provide safe environments for every student. This includes teaching students and staff about bullying and harassment, and providing methods to report and respond to any of these incidents. We have a PPS threat assessment team to help address reports of safety concerns. We also support the district-wide implementation of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS), and Restorative Justice practices through our Multi-tiered System of Supports (MTSS) department.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Rigler has a thriving SUN program, which provides students with multiple academic and enrichment activities including: folklorico dance, music, engineering, STEAM, Lego, Math opportunities. We are also beginning community Soccer Saturdays that are multi-cultural and unifying of our diverse community. Our 4th and 5th graders engage with the Oregon Writing Festival yearly.

PARENT ENGAGEMENT

Biweekly, Rigler hosts a coffee with the principal in Spanish and one in English. Our parents participate and help organize a yearly Día de Los Muertos Celebration, a yearly Black History Month, and a yearly Día de Los Niños Celebration. Our parents also regularly volunteer and are welcome to bring ideas and get collaborators to make their ideas a part of our school culture.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

The Cully Community is always welcome at our school events, as we count on our neighbors to volunteer as SMART reading program coaches. We welcome all to join us in supporting the success of our students. We are lucky to have much support from many community organizations like Moda health, Latino Network, Portland BackPack, and more. We are happy to talk to any community organization looking to help increase preparation for life for all students.
