## Community Updates

**How to report a pothole**

As crews transition back to regular work -- in addition to pothole patching -- we ask the public to be patient, as we continue to work through a backlog of reports. PBOT is always there for the public.

Anyone can **report potholes** online at [www.pdxreporter.org](http://www.pdxreporter.org), via email

at [pdxroads@portlandoregon.gov](mailto:pdxroads@portlandoregon.gov), or by calling the bureau's 24/7 maintenance dispatch hotline at 503-823-1700. Before reporting, it's a good idea to see if your pothole has already been reported by viewing **PBOT's pothole map**.

Renters! If you have received a termination notice, housing subsidy termination notice, or eviction court papers, you may be eligible for free legal support through the Portland Housing Bureau's Eviction Legal Defense Program. In your message, please include your name, date of birth, and whether you have received a termination notice, housing subsidy termination, or an eviction court case.

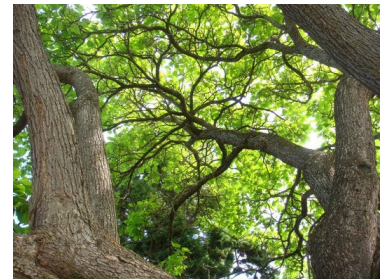

## Grants and Programs available

### Rebate Program

ODOT's Community Charging Rebates Program, which helps fund Level 2 electric vehicle projects in Oregon's communities, opened its latest funding round earlier this month.

The application window will be open through July 3, 2024 or until the funding is exhausted. This is the program's second funding round, and ODOT has \$2.5 million available for projects. Eligible businesses, nonprofits, public entities, Tribes, and owners of multifamily home complexes may apply.
