May is recognized as **National Bike Month** across the United States, highlighting the benefits of cycling for personal health, environmental sustainability, and community engagement. Join us in celebrating this nationwide movement by participating in East Portland Sunday Parkways and embracing the joy of cycling.



Construction continues on 82nd Avenue Crossings

Work is underway to construct new pedestrian crossings on 82nd Avenue, at the intersections of 82nd Avenue at **NE Beech**, **Klickitat**, and **Schuyler** streets; and **SE Clinton**, **Ash**, and **Schiller** streets. In the coming weeks, contractors with PBOT will continue curb ramp construction and excavation for electrical conduit and signal foundations. Contractors are currently working at 82nd Avenue at the intersections of NE Schuyler, SE Schiller Street, SE Ash Street, and SE Clinton Street.

Traffic impacts:

- Temporary pedestrian walkways – physical barriers will be in place to direct pedestrians around the work zone during construction.
- Temporary lane closures – one travel lane on 82nd Avenue will be closed near the work zones.
- During the Memorial Day Holiday weekend, contractors will complete construction activity by 10 a.m. Friday, May 24. No work is planned over the weekend, and no work is planned for Memorial Day, Monday, May 27.

Become a Neighborhood Tree Steward

Don't miss out on this summer's Neighborhood Tree Stewards training. Neighborhood Tree Stewards (NTS) are community members who are passionate about trees and giving back to their community. NTS graduates gain the knowledge, skills, and confidence to be stewards of Portland's urban forest. Through the NTS training program, stewards are introduced to a variety of tree-related topics to help them care for, appreciate, and advocate for the city's trees.



No previous experience is needed to become a Neighborhood Tree Steward, but you do need a passion for trees, a desire to learn, and the commitment to help. This is a great opportunity for anyone who is looking to explore the urban forestry field, learn more about trees, or wants to meet new people that care about their community.

Classes begin in mid-July and will be held every other Saturday through mid-September. Some themes that will be covered in class are:

- How to identify trees
- How to plant and care for trees
- Why our city's trees are important for people and our planet
- Opportunities to work or volunteer for trees
